Troop 281 Eagle Project Guide

The troop has put together this document for all scouts who are working towards their Eagle rank and need to do their Eagle Project. There are several steps that can be complicated when trying to complete a Project, we have gathered all these steps into this document so you know everything that needs to be done.

- Step 1. Decide on an Eagle Project
- Step 2. Talk with your scoutmaster for approval of project
- Step 3. Talk with the Benefactor of your project (The Contact at the location you are doing the work for)
- Step 4. Calculate the cost for your project, research materials/tools needed for project
- Step 5. Download the Eagle Project workbook at this location:

- Step 6. Once workbook Proposal section is filled out, schedule time with the Troop's Eagle Advisor to look over Proposal. (Make sure to include pictures and diagrams in your project plan)
- Step 7. Schedule 1st Committee Board of Review
- Step 8: Get Committee, Scoutmaster, and Benefactor signatures on Project Plan and Fund Raising Form.
- Step 9. Once Committee Board of Review is passed, Schedule District Board of Review

- Step 10. Start fundraising and requesting help for project days. (IMPORTANT: Do not start fund raising until the District approves your project, any money raised before this point cannot be used for the project.)
- Step 11. Do your Eagle Project, take lots of pictures
- Step 12. Once the project is done, start working on putting together your Project Report
- Step 13. Present your report to the Scoutmaster and Committee for final sign off
- Step 14. Take 2-3 copies of your Project Report to your District Eagle Board of Review
